Everyone's experience of sexual abuse is different. The Maggie Oliver Foundation helps survivors transform their own 'pain into power', so each can move forward on their personal journey. Without support, survivors are often isolated and alone, with no knowledge of where to turn for the help and advice they need to begin rebuilding their shattered lives. Our 'Pain into Power' support service provides a safe place for survivors to be heard.

Our fully trained and supervised volunteers provide ongoing support, a listening ear and signposting to relevant external services. Our unique approach ensures that each survivor works with the same volunteer throughout their entire engagement with the Foundation. The feedback we have received on our approach reinforces our belief that survivors benefit from developing that trusting 1:1 relationship


